Message from Diane Meier, IRTA Liaison/Legislative

The IRTA Legislative Committee met virtually in August. Steve Beebe, IRTA Lobbyist, began by filling us in on current budget concerns. The Indiana fiscal year ended on June 30 with 1.4 billion dollars less than projected. He feels this coming budget session will be the most difficult he will have seen. There was discussion of preventing raids on the teacher retirement accounts. Our committee feels strongly that we must watch and step in if there is any discussion of taking money from the accounts for anything other than the original designation.

Following are the goals the Legislative Committee presented to the IRTA Board.

- 1. IRTA should protect all revenue streams that affect retired teachers.
- 2. IRTA should request that the Legislature budget a "13th check." This money is available from the SARA account which was set up for that purpose.
- 3. Also, remember that anyone 65 or older is eligible for an absentee ballot. We encourage you to apply early and to mail it early. Regardless of our affiliation, we need to vote.

13th Check - Stipend

On September 1, those of you retired for at least a year received up to \$450 extra in your check. If you have not yet joined both ERTA and IRTA, please plan to do so. ERTA dues are \$15.00 a year, IRTA, \$35. If not for the efforts of these two organizations, you would not see the extra money in your check. This year, more than ever, we need your membership.
