I also encourage you to join our state organization, IRTA, which provides direct lobbying on our behalf. IRTA dues are only \$35 per year.

Those who attended our August luncheon heard Dr. Jennifer McCormick, the Republican candidate. We will also be recognizing our veterans at our October meeting. We are so grateful for their service.

Due to increased expenses in purchasing and preparing our meals, we have to increase our lunch price from \$10 to \$12 per meal. Executive Board Meeting

August 4, 2016

<u>Call to Order</u>: President Tom Wiggers called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. at American Baptist East Church. In addition to the president, the following were in attendance: Terry Becker, Darlene Brockriede, Fred Bullinger, Judy Isaac, Diane Meier, Don Mosbey, Fred Naab, David Pfettscher, Ed Rusk, Brenda Scheidler, Sandra Schmidt, Brenda Weber, and Lino Wiseman.



<u>Meditation</u>: Chaplain Ed Rusk read a meditation entitled "Be Careful of Your Thoughts. They May Become Words Any Minute." Then, he read Proverbs 16:23 and prayed.

<u>Acceptance of Agenda</u>: The president asked that the agenda be accepted with flexibility. David Pfettscher made a motion to accept the agenda with flexibility. Brenda Weber seconded the motion. The motion passed.

<u>Approval of May 5, 2016 Executive Board Minutes</u>: The minutes were accepted as corrected to read that two hundred dollars was allocated for candy to fill over 40 baskets.

Officer Reports:

<u>Treasurer</u>: Lino Wiseman distributed the financial report for June 30, 2016. He reported \$1,368 was withdrawn from the checking account and deposited into the Hensley Scholarship Account, leaving \$1,998.82 in checking. (Note: The balance must be under \$2,000 at the end of our fiscal year.)

<u>President</u>: Tom spoke about awards that were presented at the IRTA Representative Assembly held in Indianapolis on June 15, 2016. The IRTA Public Relations Committee selected ERTA as "Outstanding" in the following areas: Press Release, Newsletter, Website, and Group Project. Lino Wiseman was selected as the "Outstanding Volunteer" in our area and received the AMBA Clock Award. Earsie Kelly, Diane Meier, and David Pfettscher received "Honorable Mention" as volunteers.

ERTA received a note from the IRTF Board thanking us for the generous contribution to the Silent Auction held during the Representative Assembly. The proceeds will fund many of the Foundation's programs. (ERTA's contribution was a blanket purchased from Unchartered International.)

<u>Immediate Past President</u>: Brenda Weber read a thank you note from American Baptist East thanking us for the \$200 contribution to the church.

<u>President-Elect</u>: Terry Becker reported the Rescue Mission can no longer provide lunch for the price they have been charging. In addition, we must pay for the number of reservations made, even if the member or members didn't come. What we charge needs to cover the cost of the room and paper products used. Brenda Weber made a motion to charge \$15 if the Rescue Mission provides a dessert. Lino seconded. The motion didn't pass. David Pfettscher made a motion to raise the price to \$12. Diane Meier seconded. The motion passed.

Committee Reports:

Auditing and Budget: The books were audited and found to be in order.

<u>Community Service</u>: Members of ERTA volunteered over 30,000 hours last year. Tom suggested having members turn in their hours periodically instead of at the end of the year. This might give us an increased number of volunteer hours to report to IRTA.

<u>Membership</u>: Darlene Brockriede reported that 100 August newsletters were mailed. Fourteen new retirees will be attending this month's luncheon. Tom said that he would like to have all dues paid by the October luncheon.

Reservations: There were 149 reservations for next week's luncheon.

<u>Special Projects</u>: Immediate Past President Andy Guarino selected Hangers as his project. A check for \$1,266 was awarded to Hangers at a recent school board meeting. Tom reported the total amount donated to the clothing bank for our fiscal year was \$2,404, which included the \$1,138 that members donated at the December luncheon.

<u>Scholarships</u>: Diane Meier announced that information about the availability of the Hensley won't be distributed to teachers until December. The funds in the Hensley will be depleted in four years.

<u>IRTA Liaison/Legislative</u>: Diane said IRTA will continue to work for a COLA, which teachers haven't received since 2007. She noted that IRTA is non-partisan. Diane reported that she will be attending a meeting next week.

New Business:

- 1. Baskets filled with candy will be distributed to all of the EVSC schools on August 8, 2016, to welcome teachers back to school.

- 4. Tom welcomed Fred Bullinger, Terry Becker, and Don Mosbey to the board.

<u>President's Report</u>: Tom spoke briefly about the IRTA Representative Assembly held in Indianapolis on June 15, 2016. ERTA was one of three associations in the state named "Outstanding" in all of the following areas: Press Release, Newsletter, and Website. Lino Wiseman was named "Outstanding Volunteer" for our area due to his volunteer efforts with Hangers. He received the AMBA Clock Award.

Tom announced that a check for \$1,266 was awarded to Hangers at a recent school board meeting. Adding the \$1,138 members donated at the December meeting, our total donations to Hangers this fiscal year were \$2,404.

<u>Lunch</u>: Those seated at the head table were dismissed for meal service followed by members and their guests.

<u>A Word of Thanks</u>: Tom thanked Rescue Mission, Ed and Ruby Rusk, and Don and Susan Mosbey for getting everything ready for our luncheon.

<u>Luncheon Price</u>: Tom announced that the board voted to increase the price of lunch to \$12 beginning with the October meal. He asked that members bring correct change or pay with a check.

<u>Frog Follies</u>: Jim Sharp, chair of this committee, reported 94 volunteers had signed up to register cars on August 26 and 27.

One of the reasons Dr. McCormick said that she is a candidate for State Superintendent of Public Instruction is that she believes leadership is lacking at all levels. When it comes to standardized tests, she thinks that all Indiana school corporations should be surveyed about the type of test to be be given. On the topic of merit pay, she said that she is not a supporter. Dr. McCormick concluded by answering questions.


