December 3, 2015



<u>Call to Order</u>: President Brenda Weber called the meeting to order at 1:02 p.m. at the Phipps Center. In addition to the president, the following board members were in attendance: Brenda Beeler, Darlene Brockriede, Judy Isaac, Diana Luck,

Diane Meier, Fred Naab, Darla Olberding, David Pfettscher, Ed Rusk, Brenda Scheidler, Sandra Schmidt, Ron Talley, and Lino Wiseman.

The president asked that today's agenda be accepted with flexibility. David Pfettscher made a motion to accept today's agenda with flexibility. Brenda Scheidler seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

<u>Meditation</u>: Chaplain Ed Rusk read a meditation entitled "God Never Asks About Our Ability or Inability – Just Our Availability" and Isaiah 6:8. Then, he prayed.

Approval of October 1, 2015 Executive Board Minutes: The minutes were approved as printed.

Officer Reports:

<u>Treasurer</u>: Lino Wiseman distributed the financial report for October of 2015. Members didn't have any questions.

Brenda said that she believes the board needs to address the cost of mailing the newsletters next year since it is so expensive. At this time sixty-seven are being mailed. Some discussion followed; however, no definite decision was made.

Thanks to everyone who turned in volunteer hours for 2015. ERTA folks have really given back to the community with their services. A total of 32,037 hours was recorded. These hours are used when we talk to the legislators lobbying for them to remember us when they are making budget decisions. Last year throughout Indiana more than one million hours were volunteered by Indiana teachers.

Please keep a record of your 2016 hours. Practically everything counts unless you are caring for your own family members. I will be collecting your hours next December. Let's try to reach 35,000 hours this year. Listed below are *some* of the ways volunteer hours may be accumulated.

Youth Hours

Church: preparation, teaching, youth groups, VBS **Community Service**: Scouts, 4-H, coaching, CASA, Special Olympics **Education**: classroom, libraries, speech meets, Read Across America

Other Hours

Church: boards, committees, teaching, mission, calling committees, choir practice, choir, food preparation **Community Service**: Kiwanis, VFW, Lions, Rotary, Meals on Wheels, Frog Follies, ERTA, Food Pantry, AARP, ETFCU, Ronald McDonald House, Otters, United Caring Services

Health Care: hospital visits, nursing home visits/programs, fundraising for charities, chauffeuring others to appointments, Red Cross
