Executive Board Meeting

March 4, 2021

<u>Call to Order</u>: President Janet Leistner called the Zoom meeting to order at 1:09 p.m. and welcomed Lynn Arteberry, Doris Beard, Brenda Beeler, Darlene Brockriede, Fred Bullinger, Janet Craig, Judy Isaac, Walt Lewis, Diana Luck, Diane Meier, Don Mosbey, Darla Olberding, and Lino Wiseman. Sandra Schmidt was in attendance by phone.

<u>Recognition</u>: Janet gave a shout out to Lana Burton, Carol Koehler, and Walt Lewis for being inducted into the EVSC Hall of Fame. She also recognized Lynn Arteberry, who will become our next treasurer.

<u>Approval of December 3, 2020, Executive Board Minutes</u>: The minutes were approved as printed.

Officer Reports:

<u>Treasurer</u>: Lino Wiseman said that he had sent a financial report to board members in January. There were no questions. The report will be filed for audit.

He also said that he had sent the Proposed Budget for 2021/2022 in February. He noted that dues paid for 2020/2021 will carry over for 2021/2022.

Janet suggested that a membership form be sent to members by email or letter to those without a computer. The form would need to be returned by October 31, 2021, in order for members to be listed on the roster for 2021/2022. Members can donate or pay dues if any wish to do so.

<u>Secretary</u>: Sandra Schmidt thanked Janet Craig for taking the minutes at the last four meetings.

Sandra announced that she had been sending the names of educators who had passed away to IRTA as the association had requested. Thanks to those members who have notified her of an educator's passing.

<u>President-elect</u>: Janet Craig suggested that ERTA give a gift to Suzanne Williamson, the secretary at Embrace Church, who is retiring. Darla Olberding made a motion to give a \$25 gift card. Brenda Beeler seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Janet said that ERTA had awarded ten gift cards in December. After some discussion, it was suggested that we go back to three gift cards each for March and May. Lino Wiseman made a motion to award three gift cards for each of the two months. Don Mosbey seconded. The motion passed.

Committees:

<u>Membership</u>: Darlene reported sending 293 newsletters. Those who send in a membership form receive a newsletter, even those who do not pay.

Janet complimented Darlene on a job well done.

<u>Program/Luncheon</u>: Janet said that the same reservation form will be used for the luncheons when we resume, possibly in May.

<u>Publications</u>: Janet related that she sees our newsletter as a very positive tool. She congratulated Diana Luck.

<u>Publicity</u>: Doris Beard is continuing to keep up the Facebook page.

<u>Scholarship</u>: Diane Meier will contact last year's recipients in December to learn if any of them are not going to attend the conference, workshop, etc., for which the money was awarded. The money awarded to those who will not be attending will be divided among those who will be attending. She noted that she had already heard from all but four.

IRTA Liaison/Legislative: Diane said that Bill 1227 has passed the House. This bill provides for the thirteenth check and a \$50 increase. She asked that members contact their senators.

Historian: Darla Olberding asked if the locked filing cabinet had been opened and learned that it had not.
