Executive Board Meeting August 3, 2023

<u>Call to Order</u>: President Doris Beard called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. at Embrace Church and welcomed everyone. In addition to the president, the following were in attendance: Lynn Arteberry, Brender Beeler, Karen Bippus, Fred Bullinger, Frankye Calloway, Jan Craig, Earsie Kelley, Janet Leistner, Diana Luck, Donna Lutz, Diane Meier, Darla Olberding, David Pfettscher, Donna Schmidt, Sandra Schmidt, and Jane Staton.

Approval of Minutes from May 4, 2023: The minutes were accepted as written.

<u>Board Member Introductions</u>: Doris asked Frankye Calloway and Earsie Kelley, who are new board members this year, to tell a little about themselves. The remaining members did the same.

Officer Reports:

<u>Past President</u>: Jan Craig spoke about magnets that list the board and luncheon meetings for 2023/2024. They will be available at next week's luncheon.

Treasurer: Lynn Arteberry gave the following report:

Form NP 20 was filed this year; however, it no longer needs to be filed annually. The next filing will be in 2025.

Form 990N was also filed, but it must be filed each year to remain exempt from filing income taxes. Darla Olberding will audit the books after today's meeting.

The budget is ready to be approved.

Thank you notes have been received from UE and USI for our scholarship donations.

Committee Reports:

Community Service/Volunteer Hours: Forms to record volunteer hours will be available at a later date.

<u>Fellowship/Necrology</u>: Donna Lutz asked that members notify her if a card needs to be sent. She added that she needs to know what kind of card - Get Well, Sympathy, etc.

<u>Membership</u>: Janet Leistner said that she had received some membership forms. Dues will be collected at the August and October luncheons. New retirees have been contacted. Janet added that a new membership list will be distributed in October.

<u>Publications</u>: Diana Luck spoke briefly about the newsletter and said that some are being mailed. Brenda Beeler notifies her when an educator passes away.

<u>Reservations</u>: Janet Leistner reported that there are 91 luncheon reservations at this time.

Special Projects: Frog Follies will be held August 25-27, 2023.

<u>Scholarships</u>: Diane Meier recommended that the remaining funds in Hensley be given to the Teacher Locker. Lynn Arteberry said that the remaining amount totals \$7,219.19.

Diane made a motion that the remaining amount of \$7,219.19 in the Hensley be donated to Teacher Locker. Darla Olberding seconded the motion. After a brief discussion, a vote was taken, and the motion passed unanimously. The check will be made out to the EVSC Foundation with a memo that it is for Teacher Locker.

<u>IRTA Liaison</u>: Diane Meier commented on the 13th Check saying that it would have passed, but it didn't get out of Committee.

Historian: Darla Olberding noted that our newsletters tell the story of ERTA.

Information Items:

- 2. IRTA Area 9 Representative Gene VanStone will attend next week's meeting.
- 3. The fall workshop will be held on September 26, 2023, at the Rockport United Methodist Church.

Old Business:

<u>Frog Follies</u>: Jim Sharp needs 90 - 100 volunteers to work at the event. Each shift is three hours. <u>New EVSC Retirees Reception</u>: Jan Craig and Janet Leistner were permitted to inform new retirees about ERTA at the reception.

New Business:

<u>Candy Baskets</u>: David Pfettscher announced that baskets of candy will be delivered to EVSC Schools on August 4, 2023, to welcome teachers back to the classroom.

<u>Lunch</u> <u>Costs</u>: Lynn Arteberry reported that the amount charged for lunch was increased to \$15 this year to help pay for expenses. The cost to rent the room at the church is now \$300, an increase of \$50.

<u>Scholarship</u> <u>Contributions</u>: Lynn also reported that memorial contributions of five dollars will be made to each university (UE and USI) when an ERTA member passes away. She added that members have donated \$900 to the scholarship fund.

Adjournment: Diane Meier made a motion to adjourn, and Diana Luck seconded. The meeting was adjourned at 2:40 P.M.

Evansville Retired Teachers Association Luncheon Meeting August 10, 2023

<u>Call to Order</u>: President Doris Beard called the meeting to order at noon and welcomed everyone. She asked new retirees and new attendees to stand. Then she asked those who celebrate a birthday in August or September to stand.

Introduction of the Head Table: The president introduced Past President Jan Craig, today's speaker Steve Haaff and his wife, and Jeffrey Berger of Teacher Locker.

<u>Blessing/Prayer</u>: Steve Fritz related the story of a pastor who befriended a child who later died. A note was found in her red pocketbook along with 57 cents. The note said that the money was for building a new church so more children could come. The story was printed in the newspaper. As a result, \$250,000 was donated within five years. It is amazing what God can do with 57 cents.

Temple Baptist Church has 3,300 attendees.

<u>Pledge of Allegiance</u>: Doris led attendees in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Lunch: Past President Jan Craig dismissed those seated at the Head Table. Members and guests were dismissed by tables. Each table was labeled with the name of a school item.

Business:

<u>Luncheon Meeting Minutes from May 12, 2023</u>: With no objections or corrections, the minutes were accepted as written.

Indiana <u>Retired Teachers Association</u>: IRTA Area 9 Representative Gene VanStone spoke about IRTA and encouraged participation in the association.

Volunteer Opportunities:

<u>Teacher Locker</u>: Jeffrey Berger spoke about how Teacher Locker supports EVSC teachers. In 2022/2023, 650 teachers shopped, and there were 850 shopping experiences. Over \$125,000 in school supplies were put into the schools. More than 200 different items are in stock. Volunteers are needed.

<u>Evansville Docent Program</u>: Charlene Talley and Fran Riley, who are representatives of the Evansville Museum Docent Association, were available to hand out information about the association which is comprised of volunteers. More volunteers are needed. An informational coffee is scheduled for Thursday, August 17, 2023, from 9:30-11:00 a.m.

<u>Frog Follies</u>: Jim Sharp reported that approximately 3,000 cars each year are on display at this event. Ninety workers are needed. The first shift is full, but more volunteers are needed for the second and third shifts. He asked anyone who can volunteer to contact him.

Volunteer Hours: Volunteer hours will be collected in December.

<u>Candy Basket Delivery</u>: Doris asked David Pfettscher to stand and be recognized for heading this project that welcomes teachers back to the classroom.

ERTA Facebook: Doris encouraged members to take a look at the website.

Those in attendance were asked to move to the sanctuary for the program.

Program:

Doris introduced Steve Haaff, a retired Spencer County teacher who is an expert on Thomas Lincoln, the father of President Abraham Lincoln. Mr. Haaff gave some background information that included how Thomas Lincoln and his family came to live in Indiana. Mr. Haaff also spoke about Thomas Lincoln building furniture and showed slides of some of the furniture. Some pieces are in museums.

Mr. Haaff was presented with a gift certificate.

Door Prizes: Drawings were held for three gift certificates.

Adjournment: The meeting was adjourned at 1:58 p.m.
